This involved the formation of committees to establish health requirements and examination guidelines. 

Journey of Expatriate



1- Appointment Booking

Accessing the Wafid website and booking a medical appointment (Slip validity is 30 days).

2- Medical Examination

Do medical examination (within a period not exceeding 3 days).

3- Medical Report

Uploading the medical report to the Wafid system.

4-Integration with the relevant authorities

Sending the medical report to the relevant authorities through electronic integration (medical report validity is 60 days).

5-Completing the procedures

Completing the procedures for the arrival of the expatriate from the concerned country.


